

ACTIVE LEARNING – ENTRANT

Description

The Active Learning, Entrant level milestone badge certifies the recipient has acquired the foundational information on active learning and can implement the best practices for student engagement in the classroom.

Outcomes

Upon successful completion of the Active Learning, Entrant Level, participants should be able to have a portfolio that documents the following proficiencies:

- 1. **describe** the concept of active learning
- 2. **define** the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning and how it benefits the teaching and learning process in the classroom
- 3. **describe** the main concepts behind flipping the classroom, providing advantages and disadvantages
- 4. **identify and implement** several active learning strategies
- 5. **define** the major characteristics of peer supplemental instruction



Completion Criteria

In order to receive a milestone badge for Active Learning, Entrant Level, the following deliverables must be completed:

1. Satisfactory completion of five (5) workshop hours on the Active Learning track

Milestone Badge

You can apply for the milestone badge by visiting the GGC Academic Commons, located at http://commons.ggc.edu. Once there, you can click on Badge Library menu item, and locate the Active Learning Entrant milestone badge using the filters on the left of the page or the actual badge listings. Once you have located the badge and reviewed the criteria, you can click on the "Apply for Badge" button.

NOTE: Verification and badge application processing time will take 24-48 hours. Once the badge is awarded you can verify receipt by logging into the Academic Commons. Once logged in, you will receive a popup notice indicating a badge has been awarded.
