

Chemistry Faculty Learning Community Microbadge

Description

The Faculty Learning Community formed from interest among the chemistry faculty in the frameworks and methods involved in conducting chemistry education research. FLC meetings involve presenting faculty member(s) giving a brief presentation, followed by a discussion and hands-on activity to explore in detail the current day's topic. We discuss how the topic applies to projects currently underway or in development by the attending faculty members.

Course Offering

The FLC will meet 8 times: 4 meetings in Fall and 4 meetings in Spring.

Completion Criteria

In order to receive a micro badge for the course, the following deliverables must be completed:

1. Attend at least 6 meetings between Fall and Spring
2. Complete the homework assignment following the workshop. These assignments range from finding and sharing literature related to the topic to conducting analyses and presenting data.

Microbadge

You can apply for the course badge by visiting the GGC Academic Commons, located at <http://commons.ggc.edu>. Once there, you can click on the Badge Library menu item, and locate the Chemistry Faculty Learning Community microbadge using the filters on the left of the page or the actual badge listings. Once you have located the badge and reviewed the criteria, you can click on the "Apply for Badge" button.

NOTE: Verification and badge application processing time will take 24-48 hours. Once the badge is awarded you can verify receipt by logging into the Academic Commons. Once logged in, you will receive a popup notice indicating a badge has been awarded.
