

CRITICAL THINKING – PRACTITIONER

Description

Faculty design customized and approved critical thinking learning objects for implementation in a specific course and lead faculty efforts to assess and evaluate the critical thinking of GGC students.

Outcomes

At the end of the Practitioner Level of the Critical Thinking Track, faculty will be able to:

1. Integrate critical thinking learning objects into specific courses.
2. Lead faculty groups in the interpretation and assessment of students' critical thinking as measured by the CAT.

Completion Criteria

Faculty achieve Practitioner Level by earning three microbadges:

- Critical Thinking Microbadge 3: Lead one CAT GGC faculty scoring session.
- Critical Thinking Microbadge 4: Participate in a second CAT GGC faculty scoring session.
- Critical Thinking Microbadge 5: Attend a CTE Critical Thinking Learning Objects workshop and have two CAT apps approved for implementation into a specific course.

Milestone Badge

You can apply for the milestone badge by visiting the GGC Academic Commons, located at <http://commons.ggc.edu>. Once there, you can click on Badge Library menu item, and locate the Critical Thinking, Practitioner milestone badge using the filters on the left of the page or the actual badge listings. Once you have located the badge and reviewed the criteria, you can click on the “Apply for Badge” button.

NOTE: Verification and badge application processing time will take 24-48 hours. Once the badge is awarded you can verify receipt by logging into the Academic Commons. Once logged in, you will receive a popup notice indicating a badge has been awarded.
