### **Description**

#### **Outcomes**

Upon successful completion of the Faculty Foundations, participants should be able to:

- 1. **understand** and **develop** their professional identity and how this one fits within the GGC culture,
- 2. **apply** the GGC mentoring process to mentor students,
- 3. **understand and apply** the tools available for mentoring students,
- 4. **understand** the principles behind the internationalization efforts taking place at GGC,
- 5. **understand** and apply formative assessments to their teaching.



### **Completion Criteria**

In order to receive a milestone badge for Faculty Foundations , the following deliverables must be completed:

- 1. Satisfactory completion of 6 mandatory workshops listed below:
  - a. Mentoring I Tools
  - b. Mentoring II Process
  - c. ILE I
  - d. ILE II
  - e. Formative Assessment Tools CAT I
  - f. Formative Assessment Tools CAT II
- 2. Completion of two (2) electives from the following list:
  - a. Professional Identity at GGC
  - b. Course Design I
  - c. Work Life Balance and the Reflective Practitioner
  - d. How to Develop a SoTL Project
  - e. Introduction to Experiential Learning

## **Milestone Badge**

You can apply for the course badge by visiting the GGC Academic Commons, located at <a href="http://commons.ggc.edu">http://commons.ggc.edu</a>. Once there, you can click on Badge Library menu item, and locate the Faculty Foundations 17-18 badge using the filters on the left of the page or the actual badge listings. Once you have located the badge and reviewed the criteria, you can click on the "Apply for Badge" button.

**NOTE**: Verification and badge application processing time will take 24-48 hours. Once the badge is awarded you can verify receipt by logging into the Academic Commons. Once logged in, you will receive a popup notice indicating a badge has been awarded.
