

## LRNG 193 – The Flipped Classroom

### Description

This Flipped Classroom will introduce you to the flipped classroom model (FCM) and explain how to incorporate the different components gradually or all at once into your courses. Participants will learn why to flip their courses, the many benefits of a flipped classroom, and how to go about doing it, what has worked and how to continue to improve on it for my classroom. In this workshop, we will discuss the nuts and bolts of flipping your class. Flipping your class frees up class time to engage in more experiential learning activities.

- **discuss** experience facilitating class using innovative technologies and **suggest** best practices.
