

LRNG 193 – How Service-Learning Transformed My Teaching

Description

The audience for this workshop is faculty who are interested in learning more about service-learning. The vision is for this workshop to serve as an instrument for personalizing the subject by bringing participants on my pedagogical journey of discovery and transformation from lecture-based instruction to experiential learning. Faculty members who are experiencing doubts about their teaching and pedagogy are also a potential audience for this workshop because it focuses on how the workshop facilitator grappled with a “crisis of confidence” in their own teaching by experimenting with new approaches and exploring pedagogical research. Ultimately, this workshop will model how college instructors should adopt a learning curve approach to their teaching career.

Outcomes

Upon successful completion of the How Service-Learning Transformed My Teaching workshop, participants should be able to:

1. **learn** the fundamentals of service learning pedagogy.
2. **explore**, through examples of student work, the benefits of experiential and service learning pedagogy.
3. **reflect** on their teaching careers, focusing on how they followed a “learning curve” to improve their teaching.
