1. Review CTE Digital Badging Initiative

4. Briefly review several active learning strategies
5. Choose an active learning strategy and design a rough plan for implementation in your course
6. Present and discuss rough plans for constructive group feedback
7. Post workshop: finish plan, test it out and report reflections to group for continued discussion (and earn the workshop button!)

Completion Criteria

In order to receive a micro badge for the course, the following deliverables must be completed:
