

Experiential Learning Track – Entrant LEVEL

Description

The Experiential Learning Track, Entrant level milestone badge certifies the recipient has acquired the foundational information on how to effectively plan, create and deliver an experiential learning experience at Georgia Gwinnett College.

Outcomes

Upon successful completion of the Experiential, Entrant Level, participants should be able to have a portfolio that documents the following proficiencies:

1. **Understand** experiential learning foundations (definitions, learning cycles, John Dewey philosophy of teach and learning, and the role of reflection)
2. **Identify** and **setup** essential elements of the service-learning
3. **Understand** the value of community partnerships in teaching, both on and off of GGC's campus
4. **Understand** and **identify** strategies for enhancing meaning and motivation in the classroom
5. **Understanding** and/or to ability do two or more of the following:
 - **Cultivate** a classroom narrative
 - **Identify** how sustainability is intrinsic in every discipline
 - **Define** and **understand** what it means to be a reflective practitioner, and faculty well-being's vital role and effect on the classroom environment

Completion Criteria

In order to receive a milestone badge for the Experiential Learning, Entrant Level, the following deliverables must be completed:

1. Satisfactory completion of LRNG 150 – Experiential Learning 101
2. At least two of the following:

- LRNG 151 – Service-Learning 101
- LRNG 152 – Reflection
- LRNG153 – Meaning and Motivation
- LRNG 154 – Community Engagement – 5Miles Out

3. At least two of the following:

- LRNG 193 – Weaving Your Course Narrative
- LRNG 193 – Sustainability in Every Classroom
- LRNG 193 –The Reflective Practitioner

Milestone Badge

You can apply for the milestone badge by visiting the GGC Academic Commons, located at <http://commons.ggc.edu>. Once there, you can click on Badge Library menu item, and locate the Experiential Learning Milestone badge using the filters on the left of the page or the actual badge listings. Once you have located the badge and reviewed the criteria, you can click on the “Apply for Badge” button.

NOTE: Verification and badge application processing time will take 24-48 hours. Once the badge is awarded you can verify receipt by logging into the Academic Commons. Once logged in, you will receive a popup notice indicating a badge has been awarded.
